His legacy remains a beacon of consistency, commitment, and unwavering love for Cuba and its just causes. These virtues were recognized with the Friendship Medal, awarded by the Council of State of the Republic of Cuba. This distinction, which he wore with pride, attests to the profound gratitude of our people for his invaluable work.

A man deeply devoted to Fidel, he made his devotion to Commander-in-Chief Fidel Castro Ruz and the Cuban Revolution the driving force behind his work. Through the creation of the Amílcar Cabral Ideological School Movement (ACIS-M), he institutionalized a space for political education and solidarity with a clear focus on our process, organizing and participating in countless actions that demonstrated his unconditional support.

We hold with special emotion the memory of the greeting card he sent from Nigeria to the Convention Palace for Fidel on his birthday, as well as the moving African Vigil he organized in his honor. His systematic participation in our May Day celebrations, his active involvement in continental events, and, notably, his role as coordinator and soul of the 6th African Continental Solidarity Meeting with Cuba in Abuja, 2019, demonstrated his ability to mobilize and his leadership in our common struggle. As Coordinator of the Solidarity Movement with Cuba in Nigeria and Co-Secretary of the Nigerian Movement for the Liberation of Western Sahara, he skillfully united the most just causes under the banner of anti-imperialism.

Abiodun Aremu was a faithful follower of the ideas of Che, Fidel, Abel Santamaría, and all those who gave their lives for the freedom of peoples. His example of internationalism, sincere friendship, and revolutionary conviction will endure forever.
